Undesignated Voluntary Contributions

- The 'Special Account for Undesignated Contributions' was established by the GC in 1982.
- To be credited with all voluntary contributions for which no purpose is specified by the donor or *un-earmarked*.
- The amount accumulated may be used for special projects recommended by the SC and approved by the GC.
- Interest earned on this account shall be credited to this Special Account.

Undesignated Voluntary Contributions

- Revenue:
 - unsolicited donations, including individual legacies
 - interest income earned on this account
- Two standing authorizations:
 - a. Resolution GC/34/R9, paragraph 2 (ii): up to €55 440 (US\$ 80 000 @0.693) per year to finance a Visiting Scientist Award; and
 - b. Resolution GC/58/R12, paragraph (1): up to €80 000 per year to finance two twelve-month Fellowships.

Undesignated Voluntary Contributions

 In 2016, the Governing Council also granted a standing authorization to the Director, for the period 2016-2020, to allocate actively mobilized *un-earmarked* funds from the Special Account for Undesignated Contributions to five priority projects of the Agency without having to wait for the following Governing Council meeting.

Request for GC

To enable the smooth operations of the Agency, the Governing Council is requested to approve a similar mechanism as in 2016, for the period 2021-2025, by granting a standing authorization to the Director to allocate mobilized *un-earmarked* funds from the Special Account for Undesignated Contributions without having to wait for the next Governing Council meeting to the following four priority projects:

- a) Global Initiative for Cancer Registry Development (GICR)
- b) IARC Monographs and IARC Handbooks of Cancer Prevention
- c) IARC Training Fellowships
- d) IARC Nouveau Centre Plus
