- 9. The regular budget 2018–2019 was approved by the Governing Council in May 2017 amounting to €44.15 million, fully funded from assessment of contributions from Participating States, of which €21.91 million was allocated to 2018 and €22.24 million was allocated to 2019.




Figure 3: Value of contracts signed in 2019 and top nine donors (amount in million euros)
