## REQUEST FOR SUPPORT FROM THE GOVERNING COUNCIL SPECIAL FUND

- 1. The Director presented the request for an allocation of €500 000 from the Governing Council Special Fund (GCSF) for the purchase of scientific equipment (€285 000) and for the replenishment of the EPIC Biobank (€215 000) to the Scientific Council for its consideration in February 2018 (see Document SC/54/7).
- 2. The Scientific Council strongly supported this request and, given the uncertainty of the costs for the replenishment of the EPIC Biobank, recommended that the Governing Council approves the allocation of €535 000 from the GCSF, an amount higher than that initially requested by the Director, for the purchase of the equipment listed below (€285 000) and for the replenishment of the EPIC Biobank (€250 000) (see pages 13–14 of Document GC/60/4).

- 3. The annual maintenance costs of the requested equipment will be covered by the regular budget as well as by collaborative programmes through grant applications.
- 4. The Governing Council is requested to approve at its 60<sup>th</sup> Session in May 2018 the use of €535 000 from the GCSF. For the information of the Council, as at 1 January 2018, the GCSF account had an opening fund balance of €11.2 million, of which over 60% have been committed.
